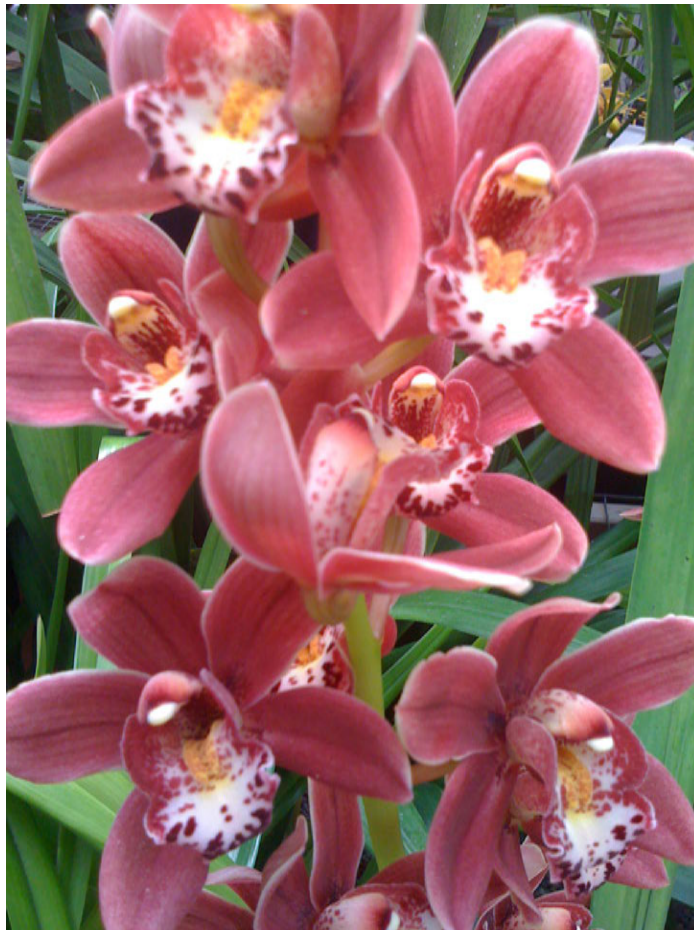

ABOUT THE SALE:

1. You must be a member of the Sacramento Valley Cymbidium Society to sell plants. You may join or renew your membership the night of the sale. Anyone may buy plants – invite all your friends!
2. Plants must be free of pests and disease and have a name. All types of orchids may be sold (cyms, paphs, phrags, phals, etc.), but they must have an identification tag in their pot.
3. Supplies may be anything related to the culture of orchids, lights, books, trays, etc.

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR ITEM FOR SALE:

There are two forms you must fill in:

- a. SVCS Plant/Item Sale Log Sheet.
- b. Plant / Item Sale Tag. One per Plant / Item.

SVCS PLANT / ITEM SALE LOG SHEET

1. Print out the form. Fill in your name at the top of the sheet
2. Enter the number for each item you wish to sell. The number will consist of your first and last initial and the sequential number of the item. For example, my name is Schelly Numrych so my six items for sale will be numbered as: SN1, SN2, etc.
3. Enter the plant or item name.
4. Enter the price you want for this item in the PRICE column.
5. Do not fill in the Sold Price column.
6. If you wish to donate this item and its proceeds to the club and receive a charitable donation, check the Donated box or write "yes".

PLANT / ITEM SALES TAG

1. Print out the form and cut the sales tags apart into six tags.
2. Fill in Member Name, Plant / Item # and Price (see explanation above).
3. If you know the color of the blossom of the plant, enter it on the tag
4. Under comment you may add any information you would like. Extra information may help you to sell the item.
5. Tape the Sales tag to the item.

Example:

Member Name:	<i>Schelly Nummich</i>
Plant/Item Name:	<i>Cym. Poetic 'Andre'</i>
Plant/Item #:	<i>541</i>
Price:	<i>\$20</i>
Color:	<i>White with suffuse pink lip</i>
Comment:	<i>Beautiful crystalline white color blossom with good form. Blossoms every year for me.</i>

PROCEDURE AT THE MEETING:

1. Bring your plants / items already labeled and your filled in sales log to the meeting.
2. Please come early (6:15 pm).
2. Present them to the Check-In Person who will check your forms.
3. Once your items have been cleared, they will be placed by a Check-In Assistant on the Sales Table.
4. You may look at the items on the Sales Table. Do not remove items from the Sales table.. No sales will take place until the President announces later in the meeting that the Sale will begin.
5. When the Sale begins, take the items you wish to purchase to the Cashier. Pay the Cashier. You will be given a receipt and your plant / item marked as PAID.
6. After the meeting, sellers will be paid 85% of the price of each sold item. They will receive their Sales Log Sheets back which will list which items sold. Sellers will then take with them any items that did not sell. Sellers may also donate any unsold items to the club and receive a charitable deduction.
